### Year 7

- Would be useful if current working grades and target grades were given on interim reports
- o Low level behaviour, specifically in some Science classes
- o Still awaiting the Homework and Revision Guide
- Electronic copy of the PE uniform list and correct dates would be useful.

#### Year 8

- Reward Points heavily favouring the girls over boys.
- Behaviour Points heavily favouring boys over girls.
  Both reward and behaviour points currently being reviewed
- Limited spaces on upcoming school trips so students disappointed to have missed out.
  This is due to limited capacity at some venues
- PE Girls seem disengaged can they play proper football matches?
- Reports not giving grades on interim reports makes it difficult when choosing options subjects
- Flexible approach to lateness due to roadworks
- Rewards points and behaviour points are being added to Arbor in a bundle, not on day of receiving the points.
- Some boys pushing younger students in the corridors, particularly English, Science and B Block stairs.

- o Parents not well informed on Mocks
- o Table Tennis tables will be moved around as Year 10s do use them
